Simple Future Tense -planning

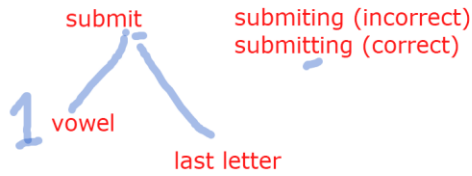
The project will be commencing next month.

He is always working at night. Present Continuous Tense — details

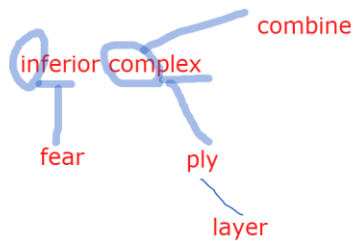
He always works at night. Simple Present Tense — Habit
